1 – General

J O'Dwyer enquired if everyone was happy to sign off on v1.0 of the IGG minutes on 07th February 2024.

2. Actions – Previous Conference Call & IGG

3. Actions – New IGG Actions

4. CRU Update

J Walsh gave the CRU Update.

C McWeeney asked if the final reporting date could be confirmed in relation to thee ECBS scheme?

J Walsh advised it would be confirmed closer to the time.

S Melvin advised that the date would be confirmed

5. Version 1 Update

R McLaughlin gave the Version 1 update.

I Mullins asked would there be further information provided on what will be required at the formal assessments planned for May 2024.

R McLaughlin advised that there would be, and it would align with the PQ assessment results submitted.

C McWeeney asked that due to v14.00.00 being more substantial then the previous v13.06.00 would the timelines be stricter than previous versions?

R McLaughlin advised that yes, timelines are very tight, and this was the reason behind issuing of the draft PQ to suppliers.

S Melvin highlighted the importance of sharing the information provided on Special Read Requests with operational teams.

I Mullins asked if the data fix will lead to replacement readings for intervals or would an adjustment for the period be issued?

C Murphy responded that yes replacement readings would be issued for incorrect interval readings with a new market message issuing. In this case the DUoS will automatically be corrected as a result.

D McBride raised a customer query based on smart meters continuing to take readings during a power outage.

C Murphy advised that this likely part of the power outage non zero estimates review currently ongoing, however if he wanted to send on MPRN examples we could check.

A O'Lachtnain asked if when work is complete should suppliers expect the 343 Market Message to reconcile with the 345 Market Message correctly?

C Murphy advised that a response on this would need to be given at a later date as this is still under review.

A O'Lachtnain stated the importance of reconciling the bill issued with what is displayed on the meter.

C Murphy agreed.

C Murphy highlighted the ability for suppliers to have visibility of the next read date on extranet and also view read cycle within the XML file in relation to the Special Read Request topic.





A O'Lachtnain asked if the item relating to installation of a night storage heater be removed from the tariff sheet at the next version?

E Corcoran responded that a response would be given on this at a later date.
