1 - General

J O'Dwyer enquired if everyone was happy to sign off on v1.0 of the IGG minutes from 9th April 2025.

Minutes Approved.

2. Actions - Previous Conference Call & IGG

One action item has been carried forward.

I Mullins requested further discussion on action item 1175.

K Tobin raised multiple points to highlight why this action will be closed as there is no further action to be taken at this time.

I Mullins advised the impact of this outage is high and during peak times makes operations more difficult. Request for ESBN to review this again.

C Murphy advised it has been reviewed and at this time there is no action to be taken.

I Mullins advised this will cause further issues in the future and wants the action to remain open.

D McBride supports I Mullins position.

C Murphy advised ESBN will not be taking any action between now and the next IGG however it can be amended for MP's to issue feedback and further info on the issues caused by this outage.

Action will remain open and be amended to reflect the above.

4. CRU Update

J Walsh gave the CRU Update.

Please refer to slides.

S Melvin added that return window for unallocated funds is the $9^{th} - 16^{th}$ September and funds should not be returned before this date in order to support the appeals process.

I Mullins asked for confirmation on 'Total Domestic Electricity' refers only to P01 parameters.

5. Version 1 Update

J McKnight gave the Version1 update.

I Mullins asked if there would be any hypercare considerations.

J McKnight advised that could be taken away but at present there is no plan to have assurance cover the hypercare period but if that changes MPs will be notified.

6. Retail Market Design Update

S Hudson gave the RMDS update.

Updated Terms of Reference for TWG approval granted.

V14.3 Assurance Approach approved.

I Mullins gueried one point in the Terms of Reference for the TWG.

S Hudson confirmed this would be updated if needed.

7. MRSO Update

J Long gave the MRSO update.

8. ESB Networks Update

K Tobin gave the ESBN Update.

I Mullins asked in relation to the outage on 10th May if there were any guarantees it would not require the Sunday contingency.





K Tobin advised at this time there is no update available.

K Tobin gave an update on DR 1238. D McBride raised his email submitted on 02nd May 2025 and asked if suppliers were required to process the reads received and highlighted the impact this would have due to the number of MPRNs.

- C Murphy advised it is the decision of the supplier on what to do with the data provided.
- D McBride queried CRU's position with regard to materiality of the amounts to be re-billed and would like to get the CRUs thoughts on what is a reasonable amount for all MPs to refund or charge, whichever the case may be. J O'Dwyer replied that CRU would speak with ESBN come back to forum with a response.
- C Murphy advised the ESBN website would be updated with information MPs can direct customers to. See new Action 1176.
- C Ryan explained the complexity arising from the updated meter reads as they were of significant in number and related to 2023. A high proportion of the customer's MPRNs being sent across with new reads relate to customers who have switched to a new Supplier or have moved premises. This results in significant manual intervention, requiring additional costs. C Ryan reiterated that the Communication on the ESBN website would have to be detailed yet also protect the Smart Metering message.
- C Murphy highlights that the process for replacing reads is in operation currently and C Ryan advised BAU volumes are manageable, but this volume will cause issues.
- C Murphy responded that this is a required action by ESBN so meter read data is reflected accurately.
- C Ryan queried the timeline proposed in order for Electric Ireland to put sufficient measures in place.
- D McBride reiterated points raised above and closed off to allow I Mullins to speak.
- C Murphy advised the batch runs could be spread over 8 batches rather than 4 if that was something that the MPs considered beneficial.
- I Mullins and D McBride advised this would not make much of a difference and it would be difficult due to billing cycles.
- C Ryan highlighted main points raised again.
- C Murphy advised MPs that the communications piece will be reviewed to assist with any customer interaction issues that may arise.
- S Melvin highlighted that customers have always been estimated due to power outages and only with smart this is now visible.
- I Mullins raised further points to highlight issues with the proposed timeline and also queried the data and if this would be the only excel file being issued to customers.
- C Murphy advised while it is indicative the data will only be amended should something occur with the MPRN between generation of the list and execution of the process.





D McBride asked if it could be delayed for at least a week to allow for internal discussion on next steps. C Murphy advised the milestone planned for 17th May can be pushed out by two weeks, however the first batch date of 14th May would remain in place and would be a useful way of testing the execution of the batches.

R Hassett presented the v14.00 Hypercare Transition slides.
