CRU Policy Update

- Electricity Costs Emergency Benefit Scheme II
- 2.153 million (99%) of customers credited for Nov/Dec government electricity credit.
- 2.155 million (99%) of customers credited for Jan/Feb government electricity credit.
- 27 February: 'Effective Date'
- 1 March: Suppliers to commence crediting accounts for March/April government electricity credit.
- VAT rate to remain at 9% until end of October 2023.
- Extension to Disconnection Moratorium: CRU has decided to extend the moratorium on the disconnection of domestic customers for reasons of non-payment of account until 31 March 2023. This is an extension to the original moratorium which came into effect on 1 December 2022 and which was due to end on 28 February 2023.

- Cooling off Periods The Consumer Rights Act 2022, which came into force on November 29th, 2022, extends the cooling off period for certain "distance" or "off-premises" contracts from 14 days to 30 days.
- EAB Time of Use Tariffs CRU 20146 Comparison Tools for Time of Use Tariffs decision paper. Incorporating the text that was included in the Annex of CRU 20146, to provide clarity to suppliers on the methodology for calculating the EAB for the SST.
- Customer Messaging Smart Pay As You Go In line with CRU General Clarification <u>CRU2022974</u>, published on 3rd November 2022, amending Handbook Section B: 9.3.4 to reflect this.
- Clarifications Other published clarifications will be included as footnotes.
- EAB/Comparisons for non-domestic Customers Amending Handbook requirement 4.6.3 (e) to reflect S.I 20/2022 No Estimated Annual Bill currently exists for non-domestic customers.






Electricity Cost Emergency Benefit Scheme

- Reminder to confirm receipt of tranche payments within 1 working day
- Weekly reporting continues with reporting commencing for the 27th February Effective
 Date as well as continuing for some suppliers for the 27th October and 20th December
 Effective Dates
- Reports should be submitted by 6pm on Fridays however suppliers can run their reports from Wednesday to Wednesday or Thursday to Thursday etc and then submit them on Fridays i.e. there is no set reporting period.
- Reports submitted late may not be included in the consolidated report to CRU.

Market Message Volumes





TIBCO Housekeeping



- Suppliers are reminded of the regular housekeeping requirements e.g. database reorgs which keep EMMAs running more efficiently.
- Digital Certificates:
 - Suppliers are reminded to check their Production EMMA and Test EMMA Certificates to ensure they are kept up
 to date otherwise the EMMA will not work if the digital cert expires.
 - A notification issues to advise when a digital certificate is due to expire, usually approx. 60 days before expiry. Additional notifications issue as the expiry date moves closer.
 - Suppliers should ensure that they take action on receipt of the notifications as it can take time to get the cert procured and installed.
- Suppliers are reminded to ensure that updated contact information for the notification emails are sent to Market Message Hub Support team (<u>RetailMarketHubSupport@esb.ie</u>) to ensure that the notification emails are going to the correct people
- Infrastructure Changes
- Suppliers are requested to let the Market Message Hub Support team
 (<u>RetailMarketHubSupport@esb.ie</u>) know of any changes that may impact the TIBCO EMMA e.g. IP Address change


