








#### Introduction/background cont...









#### The objective of these workshops is to classify each MCR by consensus as:

- Included for prioritisation
  - Has a Significant improvement for all Suppliers and/or Network Operator(s) in terms of increased efficiency, reduced transaction time, reduced work effort and/or compliance. These will be brought forward for Network Operator Impact assessment.

#### Not included for prioritisation

- Is not immediately required as the market has functioned without its implementation to date satisfactorily without significant additional impact on MPs. These will not be brought forward for the Network Operator Impact assessment for this release but if a synergy is identified it may be included in a package option.
- Withdrawn
  - MPs agree that this MCR is to be assigned a permanent classification of "Withdrawn". If a similar requirement arises in the future a new DR shall have to be raised.

Notes	(Update as of 28.10.15) – It is suggested that the reasons stated above for the implementation of mandatory first names may be achieved through the introduction of Eircodes either completely or partially. It is suggested that when assessing the MCR during future prioritisation exercises, that the current context of Eircodes be taken into consideration by MPs.
