Reason for Working Practice
<p>MCR 0035 - Registration as an Implicit Request for Energisation was rejected on the basis that the MPRN Status will be published as part of the MPRN Publication facility.</p> <p>The proposal to rely exclusively on Suppliers use of the MPRN Publication as a means of avoiding the inadvertent registration of de-energised sites was not viewed as acceptable by the market participants. The following working practice formally documents a revised proposed workaround</p>

Working Practice
<p>In order to limit the possibility of a Supplier inadvertently requesting the registration of a de-energised site ESB Networks will continue its current practice of not re-energising premises unless there is a person present.</p> <p>As a further safeguard Suppliers who do not wish de-energised sites to be energised upon receipt by MRSO of a registration request should check the Energisation Status for the MPRN on the MPRN Publication web facility. In cases where the site has a de-energised status then the 010 request should not be submitted until such time as the customer is happy for the site to be energised</p>
